Two Field Turf full-sized fields (111 yards x 71 yards) with the latest single blade in-filled turf that plays like a Florida golf green. The fields can be divided to create four full-sized 8 v 8 fields with goals.

Training/warm-up area that connects both fields, up to 40 yards x 71 yards; Fitness running hill; bleachers and field enclosure rail.

Stadium lights for evening play and team dugouts for inclement weather.

Top-of-the-Line Kwik Goal Products; 10 sets of goals all movable on wheels; barrier netting to eliminate ball chasing; mini goals and additional portable goals.

Senior Academy Program (Session I) Ages 13–18

This program is designed for players age 13 and up. Modern coaching methods will be emphasized. Functional training for specific positions and roles within a team framework will be introduced. All technical instruction will be match-related. The training exercises will be physical as well as mental. The mental development of the campers is a key objective of the Program. Each day senior campers will have full-sided and small-sided matches under the supervision of USSF "A" licensed coaches. Curriculum includes: technical refinement, combination play, principles of attack and defense, individual, group and team tactics. 11 vs 11 and 8 vs 8 matches will be held Sunday—Wednesday at 6:30 pm. Final matches will be held Thursday morning at 9:30 am. Camp ends at 11 am Thursday.

Junior Academy Program (Sessions I & II) Ages 11–12

This program's philosophy is to have fun while learning. The dynamic coaching personalities of our staff will motivate the junior and youth campers. This is a key objective of this program. Curriculum includes: passing, shooting, receiving, heading, tackling, dribbling, movement with and without the ball and positional play and responsibilities. Matches will be held each evening Sunday—Wednesday and Thursday morning. Camp ends at 11 am Thursday.


